

100 THINGS THAT ACCOMPANY SALVATION

Heb 6:9 But, beloved, we are convinced of better things concerning you, and things that accompany salvation...

001. Fellowship with God's Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 Cor 1:9 God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

002. Access to the Father in Christ and through the Spirit.

Eph 2:18 for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father.

003. Access WITH confidence.

Eph 3:12 in whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him.

004. Access to grace, wherein we stand.

Rom 5:2 through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.

005. Righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Rom 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

006. Joy and peace in believing.

Rom 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

007. Abounding hope.

Rom 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

008. God working in us to will and to do.

Php 2:13 for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for *His* good pleasure.

009. The continual intercession of Jesus.

Heb 7:15 And this is clearer still, if another priest arises according to the likeness of Melchizedek,

010. The intercession of the Holy Spirit.

Rom 8:26 And in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words;

011. The privilege of walking in the light.

1 John 1:7 but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

012. Forgiveness when sin is confessed.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

013. Christ in us, the hope of glory.

Col 1:27 to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

014. The Spirit of adoption.

Rom 8:15 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

015. Being taught by God to love one another.

1 Thess 4:9 Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for *anyone* to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;

016. Being taught of the Father by Jesus.

Matt 11:27-28 "All things have been handed over to Me by My Father; and no one knows the Son, except the Father; nor does anyone know the Father, except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him*. (28) "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest.

017. Christ manifesting Himself to us.

John 14:21 "He who has My commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves Me; and he who loves Me shall be loved by My Father, and I will love him, and will disclose Myself to him."

018. The Father and the Son making their abode in us.

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him, and make Our abode with him.

019. Strength in the inner man.

Eph 3:16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man;

020. The Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

Eph 1:17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.

021. The opening of the eyes of our understanding.

Eph 1:18-19 *I pray that* the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, (19) and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. *These are* in accordance with the working of the strength of His might

022. The full assurance of hope.

Heb 6:11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end,

023. The full assurance of understanding.

Col 2:2 that their hearts may be encouraged, having been knit together in love, and *attaining* to all the wealth that comes from the full assurance of understanding, *resulting* in a true knowledge of God's mystery, *that is*, Christ *Himself*,

024. The full assurance of faith.

Heb 10:22 let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled *clean* from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

025. Being married to Christ.

Rom 7:4 Therefore, my brethren, you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, that we might bear fruit for God.

026. Bringing forth fruit to God.

029. Partaking of the Divine Nature.

2 Pet 1:4 For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, in order that by them you might become partakers of *the* divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

030. Being joined to the Lord.

1 Cor 6:17 But the one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit *with Him*.

031. Our names written in heaven.

Luke 10:20 "Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven."

Heb 12:23 to the general assembly and church of the first-born who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of righteous men made perfect,

032. An incorruptible inheritance, reserved for us in heaven.

1 Pet 1:4 to *obtain* an inheritance *which is* imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,

033. Being kept by the power of God.

1 Pet 1:5 who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

034. God keeping us from falling.

Jude 24 Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,

035. The peace of God keeping our hearts and minds.

Phil 4:7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.

Col 3:15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful.

036. Knowing Whom we have believed.

2 Tim 1:12 For this reason I also suffer these things, but I am not ashamed; for I know whom I have believed and I am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to Him until that day.

037. Being suitable for the Master's use.

2 Tim 2:21 Therefore, if a man cleanses himself from these *things*, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work.

038. Receiving grace upon grace.

John 1:16 For of His fulness we have all received, and grace upon grace.

039. Discern the extent of salvation.

Eph 3:18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,

040. Knowing the love of Christ that transcends knowledge.

Eph 3:19 and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fulness of God.

041. Being filled with all the fulness of God.

Eph 3:19 and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fulness of God.

042. Having the mind of Christ.

1 Cor 2:16 For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, THAT HE SHOULD INSTRUCT HIM? But we have the mind of Christ.

043. An anointing that teaches us to abide.

1 John 2:20-27 But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you all know. (21) I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you do know it, and because no lie is of

the truth. (22) Who is the liar but the one who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, the one who denies the Father and the Son. (23) Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father; the one who confesses the Son has the Father also. (24) As for you, let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father. (25) And this is the promise which He Himself made to us: eternal life. (26) These things I have written to you concerning those who are trying to deceive you. (27) And as for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.

044. Righteousness by imputation because of faith.

Rom 4:6-8 just as David also speaks of the blessing upon the man to whom God reckons righteousness apart from works: (7) "BLESSED ARE THOSE WHOSE LAWLESS DEEDS HAVE BEEN FORGIVEN, AND WHOSE SINS HAVE BEEN COVERED. (8) "BLESSED IS THE MAN WHOSE SIN THE LORD WILL NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT."

045. A purged conscience.

Heb 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

046. Powerful spiritual weaponry.

2 Cor 10:4-5 for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. (5) *We are* destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and *we are* taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ,

047. The whole armor of God.

Eph 6:11-18 Put on the full armor of God, that you may be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. (12) For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. (13) Therefore, take up the full armor of God, that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. (14) Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, (15) and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE; (16) in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming missiles of the evil *one*. (17) And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. (18) With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,

048. All spiritual blessings in heavenly places.

Eph 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,

049. All things pertaining to life and godliness.

2 Pet 1:3 seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

050. The spirit of power, love, and a sound mind.

2 Tim 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.

051. Everlasting consolation and good hope.

2 Thess 2:16 Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope by grace,

052. The Holy Spirit.

1 John 3:24 And the one who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And we know by this that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

1 John 4:13 By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

053. An understanding ministered by Jesus Himself.

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding, in order that we might know Him who is true, and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.

054. The love of the truth.

2 Thess 2:10 and with all the deception of wickedness for those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth so as to be saved.

055. A kingdom which cannot be moved.

Heb 12:28 Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe;

056. Spiritual nourishment by God Himself.

2 Cor 6:2 for He says, "AT THE ACCEPTABLE TIME I LISTENED TO YOU, AND ON THE DAY OF SALVATION I HELPED YOU"; behold, now is "THE ACCEPTABLE TIME," behold, now is "THE DAY OF SALVATION"--

057. Knowing the things God has freely given to us.

1 Cor 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things freely given to us by God,

058. 1 heavenly treasure in an earthen vessel.

2 Cor 4:7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the surpassing greatness of the power may be of God and not from ourselves;

059. A building of God, in the heavens.

2 Cor 5:1 For we know that if the earthly tent which is our house is torn down, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

060. A great High Priest.

Heb 8:1 Now the main point in what has been said *is this*: we have such a high priest, who has taken His seat at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens,

061. Illumination.

Heb 10:32 But remember the former days, when, after being enlightened, you endured a great conflict of sufferings,

062. Enlightenment.

Heb 1:13-14 But to which of the angels has He ever said, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I MAKE THINE ENEMIES A FOOTSTOOL FOR THY FEET"? (14) Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

071. Everything working together for our good.

Rom 8:28 And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.

072. The Lord being our Helper.

Heb 13:6 so that we confidently say, "THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT SHALL MAN DO TO ME?"

073. Pure minds.

2 Pet 3:1 This is now, beloved, the second letter I am writing to you in which I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder,

074. God being "for us".

Rom 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God *is* for us, who *is* against us?

075. A better hope--Heb 7:19

076. Blood that speaks better things than that of Abel.

Heb 12:24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than *the blood* of Abel.

077. No condemnation.

Rom 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

078. Peace with God.

Rom 5:1 Therefore having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

079. Eternal life.

1 John 5:11 And the witness is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.

080. Abundant life.

John 10:10 "The thief comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy; I came that they might have life, and might have *it* abundantly.

081. Exceeding great and precious promises.

2 Pet 1:4 For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, in order that by them you might become partakers of *the* divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

082. Being raised up to sit together with Christ.

Eph 2:6 and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places*, in Christ Jesus,

083. The Word of God building us up and giving us an inheritance.

Acts 20:32 "And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build *you* up and to give *you* the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

084. Being established by God.

2 Cor 1:21 Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God,

085. The sealing of the Holy Spirit.

2 Cor 1:21 Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God,

086. Having sufficiency from God.

2 Cor 3:5 Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as *coming* from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God,

087. A power within through which God can work transcendently

Eph 3:20 Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,

088. Having all sufficiency in all things.

2 Cor 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

089. The work of God performed in us until the day of Christ.

Phil 1:6 *For I am* confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

090. All of our need supplied according to God's glory.

Phil 4:19 And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

091. Made qualified to partake of the saint's inheritance.

Col 1:11-12 strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously (12) giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.

092. Being sanctified wholly, spirit, soul, and body.

1 Thess 5:23-24 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (24) Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass.

093. Partaking of God's holiness through chastening.

Heb 12:10 For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, but He *disciplines us* for *our* good, that we may share His holiness.

094. The victory of overcoming the world.

1 John 5:4-5 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world--our faith. (5) And who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

095. Satan being bruised under our feet.

Rom 16:20 And the God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.

096. Being called into liberty.

Gal 5:1 It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.

Gal 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brethren; only *do not turn* your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

097. Learning Christ.

Eph 4:20 But you did not learn Christ in this way,

098. Purity of soul.

1 Pet 1:22 Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart,

099. Tasting of the Lord.

1 Pet 2:3 if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord.

100. Christ has received us.

Rom 15:7 Wherefore, accept one another, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.
