

# **Jesus Christ is God.**

## **John 17:3; Acts 4:12; Isaiah 43:3,10,11**

### **1. Why must Jesus Christ be God?**

**Ans.** Because our being good enough is not good enough. **Romans 3:9-31.**

**Ans.** Because we need a perfect substitute for our many sins. **2 Corinthians 5:19,21.**

**Ans.** Because we need a sin bearer. **1 Peter 2:24; 3:18.**

### **2. Do the scriptures support Jesus Christ's Divinity?**

#### **A. Jesus calls God, His Father.**

John 5:17-18 But He answered them, "My Father is working until now, and I Myself am working." For this cause therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God. (Cf. Luke 22:70).

#### **B. Jesus claims to be God.**

John 8:19 And so they were saying to Him, "Where is Your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither Me, nor My Father; if you knew Me, you would know My Father also."

#### **C. God said that Jesus Christ is God.**

Hebrews 1:8 But of the Son [He says], "Thy throne, O God, is forever and ever, And the righteous scepter is the scepter of His kingdom.

#### **D. Jesus claimed preexistence.**

John 8:58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."

#### **E. Jesus was worshiped.**

John 9:38 And he said, "Lord, I believe." And he worshiped Him.

Hebrews 1:6 And when He again brings the first-born into the world, He says, " And let all the angels of God worship Him." (Cf. Matthew 2:11; 14:33; 28:9,17; John 9:38).

#### **F. Jesus and the Father are one essence.**

John 10:30 "I and the Father are one."

#### **G. To see Jesus was to see the Father.**

John 14:7-10 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him." Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and [yet] you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how do you say, 'Show us the Father'? "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

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**H. Jesus has ownership of all that the Father has.**

John 16:15 "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said, that He takes of Mine, and will disclose [it] to you.

**I. Doubting Thomas believes that Jesus is God.**

John 20:28 Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

**J. Christ is called God by Paul.**

Romans 9:5 whose are the fathers, and from whom is the Christ according to the flesh, who is over all, God blessed forever. Amen.

**K. Christ is the image of God.**

2 Corinthians 4:4 in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

**L. The Colossian Church new that Jesus is God.**

Colossians 1:19 For it was the [Father's] good pleasure for all the fulness to dwell in Him,

Colossians 2:9 For in Him all the fulness of Deity dwells in bodily form,

**M. Timothy says Jesus is God.**

1 Timothy 1:16-17 And yet for this reason I found mercy, in order that in me as the foremost, Jesus Christ might demonstrate His perfect patience, as an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life. Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, [be] honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 Timothy 2:3-5 This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, [and] one mediator also between God and men, [the] man Christ Jesus,

1 Timothy 3:16 And by common confession great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Beheld by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, Believed on in the world, Taken up in glory.

**N. Titus says that Jesus is God.**

Titus 2:13 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus;

**O. Christ is eternal**

Hebrews 1:3 And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high;

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Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ [is] the same yesterday and today, [yes] and forever.

**P. Jesus is the true God.**

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding, in order that we might know Him who is true, and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.

**Q. John the gospel writer says that Jesus Christ is certainly God!**

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

**R. John also states emphatically that Jesus is the Great "I AM."**

John 8:23-29 And He was saying to them, "You are from below, I am from above; you are of this world, I am not of this world. 24 "I said therefore to you, that you shall die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am [He], you shall die in your sins." 25 And so they were saying to Him, "Who are You?" Jesus said to them, "What have I been saying to you [from] the beginning? 26 "I have many things to speak and to judge concerning you, but He who sent Me is true; and the things which I heard from Him, these I speak to the world." 27 They did not realize that He had been speaking to them about the Father. 28 Jesus therefore said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am [He,] and I do nothing on My own initiative, but I speak these things as the Father taught Me. 29 "And He who sent Me is with Me; He has not left Me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to Him."

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
