The New Testament Reveals What The Old Testament Conceals

1 Cor 10:11 Now these things happened to them as an example, and they were written for our instruction, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.

I. BELIEVE: Ex. 4:1-9, 30-31

- A. Israel was & is a type of the Church. **Rom 9:6-8** *But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel; (7) neither are they all children because they are Abraham's descendants, but: "THROUGH ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS WILL BE NAMED." (8) That is, it is not the children of the flesh who are children of God, but the children of the promise are regarded as descendants.*
- B. Egypt was & is a type of Sin or the world.
- C. Moses, the deliverer, was a type of Christ, the Savior.
- D. Moses lifts the serpent by the tail but Christ crushes the head.
Exo 4:4 *But the LORD said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand and grasp it by its tail"--so he stretched out his hand and caught it, and it became a staff in his hand.*
Gen 3:15 *And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel."*
- E. Moses was healed of his leprous disease. **Ex. 4:6-7**
- F. Moses pours water on dry ground and it becomes blood. **Ex. 4:9**
- G. God showed Israel that Egypt had nothing to offer them.
- H. When you decide to leave Egypt (world). **Ex. 5:1, 17, 21-22**
- I. God shows Israel the land is corrupt. **Ex. 7:19; 8:2, 16, 24**
- J. Sacrifice in the "land" (world). **Ex. 8:25**
- K. Not very far from the world. **Ex. 8:28**
- L. Now from discomforts to destruction. World is under condemnation. **Ex. 10:7**
- M. Take your wife & cattle, but leave your children. **Ex. 10:10**
- N. Go serve the Lord, only leave your flocks & herds. (money) **Ex. 10:24**

II. REPENTANCE

- A. It is leaving the world totally without compromise.
- B. Corruption - Destruction - Dead. **Ex. 12:31-33**
- C. Not even near sin. **Ex. 13:17**
- D. Salvation is not complete. **Ex. 14:13**

III. BAPTISM: 1 Cor 10:1-2 *For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; (2) and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea;*

- A. Into the sea and cloud of Moses. **Ex. 14:21-22**
- B. Sin lay dead on the shore. **Ex. 14:30**
- C. Not one remained. **Ex. 14:28**
- D. Thus sins are dead. **Ex. 14:30**
